Predictional Report 2005

With this Report Dignity for Children intends to clarify the plans for the year 2005 to its partners. According to the agreements made by the partners and Dignity for Children it should help the local partners to plan their work and to be able to estimate what to expect from Dignity for Children in 2005. However, figures mentioned in this report cannot be seen as guaranteed.

Along with this report you get the financial report of 2003/2004. Since we are still a small association it is our aim to let everybody be part of our work through a transparent handling with each partner. That's why this report includes the predictions for all partners.

Project proposals

We would like to encourage our partners to request money from us for individual projects. For that we need detailed proposal(s) including idea, timeframe, financial plan (incl. other donors), budget, aim, indicators how to measure the aim for each project you are planning etc. However we cannot guarantee that we will be able to grant the requested funds. Still we are only able to grant small-scale funding.

Hope for Children in Ethiopia

Work with our first partner has continuously improved during 2004. In 2005 Dignity for Children will put most efforts on finding eight more sponsors for the children from the provided list that are still without a sponsor. Each child will be sponsored with a minimum of Euro 9, -- per month or Euro 108, -- per year. Administrative costs necessary in this context should be covered by this amount. If Dignity for Children will be able to find these sponsors a total of 22 children will be sponsored bringing the sponsorship amount paid to Hope for Children in Ethiopia in 2005 to a minimum of Euro 2376, --

Next to this we expect to be able to provide an estimated funding of about Euro 1500, -- for the „Independence project“, supporting a few young working street children with their professional equipment. These funds were raised through concerts in Germany and Ethiopia in close cooperation with Hope for Children in Ethiopia.

Hope for Children in Ethiopia is asked to send in proposals for additional projects.

Colibri, Peru

Our partner in Peru was the second partner we started work with. Dignity for Children wants to improve its cooperation with Colibri in 2005. A key element is a list we got from Colibri with a total of 13 children suggested to be sponsored by Dignity for Children. Finding partners for them will be an important part in the work of Dignity for Children. But also

receiving additional female sponsor children is requested. Payments for the children will also be a minimum of Euro 9, -- per month or Euro 108, -- per year (including administrative costs necessary in that context). If we are able to find 13 sponsors, Colibri will get a minimum funding of Euro 1404, -- in 2005.

Colibri is also asked and should feel encouraged to send in proposals for additional projects.

Mobile Mini Circus for Children - MMCC, Afghanistan

The Mobile Mini Circus for Children (MMCC) in Kabul, Afghanistan is our most recent partner. 2005 should be used to establish a regular cooperation basis. This includes a written agreement about the type of cooperation. MMCC does not organise sponsorships. Therefore Dignity for Children will support the partner with single projects that are necessary to keep the work going. MMCC is asked to send in proposals for these projects which Dignity for Children might be able to (co-)fund.

A key element in the cooperation between MMCC and Dignity for Children this year will be the MMCC-trip to Germany in 2005. During this trip, Dignity for Children will support the MMCC with networking, media contacts and other requested assistance.
