Predictional Report 2006

With this Report Dignity for Children intends to clarify the plans for the year 2006 to its partners. According to the agreements made by the partners and Dignity for Children it should help the local partners to plan their work and to be able to estimate what to expect from Dignity for Children in 2006. However, figures mentioned in this report cannot be seen as guaranteed.

Along with this report you get the financial report of 2005. Since we are still a small association it is our aim to let everybody be part of our work through a transparent handling with each partner. That's why this report includes the predictions for all partners.

Project proposals

We would like to encourage our partners to request money from us for individual projects. For that we need detailed proposal(s) including idea, timeframe, financial plan (incl. other donors), budget, aim, indicators how to measure the aim for each project you are planning etc. However we cannot guarantee that we will be able to grant the requested funds. Still we are only able to grant small-scale funding.

However, each partner will not be granted a new funding until Dignity for Children got the report about the last funded project. As soon as this report reached Dignity for Children, we are able to decide about the new proposal.

Hope for Children in Ethiopia

Work with our first partner grew during 2005. Dignity for Children was able to fund the Self-Dependency project as well as start a co-financed project. More than 120 children benefit from the financial support. Main effort for DFC in 2005 will be to keep this level. This includes 61 individual sponsorships each worth Euro 108,-- each year. To cover all of them means a maximum payment of Euro 6588,--. Administrative costs necessary in this context should be covered by this amount.

Also to be confirmed is the second year of payment for the Project financed by DFC and Wege zur Einen Welt.

Hope for Children in Ethiopia is asked to send in proposals for additional projects.

UNPADS, Peru

Our partner in Peru was the second partner we started work with. Dignity for Children wants to increase its cooperation with UNPADS in 2006. To go ahead with the next payment it is essential for DFC to get the reports of the organisations progress and especially about the wellbeing of the 13 children covered by DFC. All of these children have an individual sponsor

in Europe and money is ready to be transferred. This brings the minimum Sponsorship-payment to UNPADS by DFC in 2006 (including administrative costs necessary in that context) to Euro 1404, --.

DFC is interested in putting more money into UNPADS in 2006 after Hope for Children in Ethiopia got most attention in 2005. To be able to do so reliable reporting by UNPADS and proposals for additional projects are requested.

Mobile Mini Circus for Children - MMCC, Afghanistan

The Mobile Mini Circus for Children (MMCC) in Kabul, Afghanistan is facing financial problems in the beginning of 2006. DFC wants to assist as much as possible but will not be able to cover all of the financial needs. After the work agreement has been signed, DFC will try as much as possible to raise funds to help MMCC to continue its work. However, it is requested to send in reports and proposals for that. Payments than can be done on very short notice.

MMCC does not organise sponsorships. Therefore Dignity for Children will support the partner with single projects that are necessary to keep the work going. MMCC is asked to send in proposals for these projects which Dignity for Children might be able to (co-)fund.

Dignity for Children is glad to see the positive developments of our partners in Ethiopia and Peru and wants to offer all the help it can to the MMCC to help the work continue.
